

## **State College Radio Control Club Thursday November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015 Meeting Minutes**

Jon Guizar called the meeting to order at 7:00. No guests or new members were in attendance.

October Meeting Minutes. Members voted to accept the October 2015 minutes.

Treasurer's Report. Doug Schultz reported that the last porta-potty rental charge was paid and the porta-potty is now gone from the field for the season. He advised the balance of SCRC's bank account and the members voted to accept the Treasurer's report.

### **Old business –**

Field Maintenance. Jon advised that October 31<sup>st</sup> was the last of the field maintenance for the year.

### **New business –**

Indoor Flying. The date for the session that was paid for last season is set for Saturday 11/21/2015 (from 5 to 7 PM) at the CCC gym. This is for the indoor members from last year but if you were not a member of that group, you can pay \$20 to participate for that evening. Al Jones advised that the CPI cafeteria is not available and Jon reported the Bellefonte High School gym is no longer a viable option. Jon suggested that members who are interested in joining the indoor group may see Doug Shultz after tonight's meeting and pay the membership dues. We will also be collecting money for membership at the December meeting, \$80 per person for all flying sessions or \$20 per session if you wish to pay as you go.

Election Committee Report. Al Jones presented the list of candidates and explained the rules of the election to take place at next month's meeting. The officer candidates are Jon Guizar (President), Woody Brem (Vice President), Chris Ivory (Secretary), Doug Shultz (Treasurer) and Pablo Rivera (Safety Officer).

### **Meetings and Events for 2016.**

December Meeting, Swap-n-Shop. If you have some items you wish sell, please send a list of items with pictures to Jon and he will share the information. We will have food. Woody will bring drinks and Jon will bring Sloppy Joes. The meeting will be held in our usual classroom but Al Jones arranged to have it opened up to expand into the next room, providing twice the usual space.

January Meeting Family Banquet. We discussed having a banquet at CCC instead of having our regular meeting. The cost per person should be low as we will not be flying in the gym. As of now, the date is not set. We will also begin accepting 2016 dues in January.

Spikes Fest is in March. Date to be announced.

SCRC Air Show 2016. We set the date for Sunday July 24<sup>th</sup>. We need volunteers for the Air Show Committee.

IMAC Event at SCRC 2016. We plan to host another IMAC competition in August.

SCRC Fun Fly in June. We set the date for Saturday, June 11<sup>th</sup>.

YGI Program for 2016. We intend to continue the YGI program. Our March meeting should be the kick-off meeting for the outdoor flying season and YGI program plans are still being finalized.

### **Open Floor Discussion –**

Budget for 2016. Doug Schultz presented his budget for the coming year outlining income from dues, hat/shirt sales, swap meet, and IMAC. Expenses include AMA charter, field rent, grass mowing, porta-potty rental, web hosting and PO box rental. His report shows a gain for 2016. He recommended that the dues stay the same for 2016. The dues structure can be located on the website.

Name Tags and ID Cards. Al Jones asked if anyone needed SCRC name tags. Please see Al if you want a name tag. We discussed club membership ID cards. ID cards will be issued to members as they pay their dues for 2016. Jon will send the ID card template to Al Jones and Al will take care of distributing the new ID cards.

SCRC Constitution and Bylaws on the Website. Al Jones pointed out some missing and outdated information. Jon will send the latest documents to Todd Cook and he will update the website.

Doug Shultz announced that we still have SCRC hats and Shirts for sale and Jon Guizar presented the idea to build another run-up stand for the field for next season.

**Meeting Adjournment –** The motion to adjourn passed at 7:30.

**Presentation / Program –** Alan Brubaker's presentation on covering. Alan provided some great tips on building airframes and covering the surfaces with iron-on film. He took a hands-on approach by offering guidance to members who have never worked
